Re: Last 2018 Pre Rally Information

Greetings Everyone,

I am sending this at the request of a few seasoned rally entrants. We want to make sure everyone has updated information for Thursday evening. This e-mail will answer most questions (for most people).

1. We are starting at the World of Speed (W.O.S.) Museum in Wilsonville, Oregon. They are located at 27490 SW 95th Avenue, Wilsonville, Oregon 97070.
2. Wilsonville is 18.2 miles (29.29 kilometers) south of Portland just off I-5. If you use the second exit (going south) to Wilsonville you will turn right at the light and turn right again at Boones Ferry Rd. As you continue on Boones Ferry Rd you will see the W.O.S. building on your left side at Hillman Ct. Turn left at Hillman Ct and proceed to the front of the building for parking assistance.
3. Your arrival should be after 6:00 P.M for scrutineering and once completed you may proceed to registration for your packet. Please be sure you have a signed tech sheet from the scrutineer group before you proceed. You will need signatures from driver and navigator to complete the process.
4. We will be serving light hors d'oeuvres and there will be a cash bar for your refreshment.
5. As registration draws to a close we will have a brief meeting and introductions as well as answers for most of your questions. A short rally school for interested parties will commence after the meeting and will be presented across from the registration tables. We will try to get all of this done as early as possible as the temperatures are expected to be in the 90's.
6. When you receive your packet you will find a full schedule page. We will do our best to adhere to the schedule. If there are any changes we will try to keep you informed.
7. We will post parking maps in the registration so you will have a basic idea where to park on Friday morning. The main lot in front of the W.O.S. entrance will be for tour cars. Rally cars will park on the south side of the building where there will be staff to help you.
8. We will have a new Tour Master for Group 3 as our scheduled leader had an automobile accident last weekend and is mending. We will announce the tour leaders on Friday morning.

If you have any questions please bring them Thursday night and we will address them. For anything else you may contact me at 503-701-2980. We look forward to seeing you this week.
